The Eternal Purpose of God

Read: Ephesians 1:9-12; 2:4-7; 3:10-11

God has a purpose, a grand design He has willed to accomplish: He wants to display **HIS GLORY** in human redemption!

- 1. It is ETERNAL.
- 2. It is being executed even now.

God has made PROMISES relating to His purpose: seen in the fact that:

- 1. His covenants are called "the covenants of promise" (Ephesians 2:12).
- 2. His children are called "the children of promise" (Romans 9:8).
- 3. His Son is the certainty of the promise (2 Corinthians 1:20).

God has a plan by which He is moving towards the accomplishment of His purpose.

- 1. His plan centers on the work of a Person --- the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 2. His plan is committed to the care of a divinely ordained instrument:
 - a. The man of God --- using
 - b. The Word of God --- by
 - c. The Spirit of God.

God has a program by which His plan is being implemented:

- 1. A program of eight immutable covenants:
 - a. Edenic
 - b. Adamic
 - c. Noahic
 - d. Abrahamic
 - e. Mosaic
 - f. Palestinian
 - g. Davidic
 - h. New
- 2. A program of eight dispensational dealings:
 - a. Edenic
 - b. Antediluvian
 - c. Postdiluvian
 - d. Patriarchal
 - e. National
 - f. Ecclesiastical
 - g. Messianic

h. Eternal

- 3. A Program of eight righteous judgments (see my chart Eight Judgments in the Plan of God):
 - a. Christ on the Cross
 - b. Self-Examination
 - c. Chastening by God
 - d. Judgment Seat of Christ
 - e. Judgment of Nations
 - f. Judgment of the Jews
 - g. Judgment of Angels
 - h. Great White Throne Judgment

God has the power (authority and ability) to execute His program – His Sovereign Rule -- The Kingdom of God. Psalm 22:28; 103:19; Acts 1:3; and 28:30-31. **Definition**: The Kingdom of God is the sovereign rule of God. The Kingdom of God of necessity involves:

- 1. A Sovereign God as King
- 2. A Seat The Throne of Heaven
- 3. A Sphere The Domain of all time and eternity
- 4. Subjects Redeemed of All Ages and Unfallen Angels

There are six aspects of the Kingdom of God:

- 1. Ultimate The Sovereign Rule of God over the entire universe and every created being.
- 2. Spiritual The Sovereign Rule of God over the hearts of His people.
- 3. Historical The Sovereign Rule of God over national Israel.
 - a. The Theocracy Direct Rule of God as Divine King, Moses to Samuel
 - b. The Monarchy Rule of Native Kings, Saul to Zedekiah
 - i. United Kingdom Saul to Solomon
 - ii. Divided Kingdom -
 - 1. Rehoboam to Hezekiah (Judah Southern Kingdom)
 - 2. Jeroboam to Hoshea (Israel Northern Kingdom)
 - iii. Single Kingdom Hezekiah to Zedekiah (Judah)
 - c. The Dependency the rule of Alien Kings (Nebuchadnezzar to the Man of Sin)
- 4. Mystery The Sovereign Rule of God over professing Christendom
- 5. Messianic The Sovereign Rule of God over the nations of earth during the Millennial Kingdom
- 6. Eternal The Sovereign Rule of God over His redeemed Universe.

There are four manifestations of the Kingdom of God:

- 1. From Adam to Abraham Paternal in Character; Racial in Scope.
- 2. From Abraham to Christ Legal in Character; National in Scope.
- 3. From Christ to the Rapture Ecclesiological in Character; International in Scope.
- 4. From the Rapture to the Great White Throne Messianic in Character; Universal in Scope.
