A Remarkable Structure




The Tabernacle has been estimated to contain:

- 3,140 lbs. of Gold
- 9,575 lbs. of Silver
- 7,540 lbs. of Bronze
- Animal skins including Red Sea Porpoise skins
- Acacia or Shittim wood
- Gallons of Olive Oil
- Tons of Spices
- And heaps of Precious Stones


The Inner Beauty of the Tabernacle

wandering in the wilderness saw only occasional glimpses of its inner beauty




Ours is a Greater Privilege


A Few Things Before We Start





Spiritual "Realities"

Sometimes we are tempted to think that the physical is the "real" thing and that the spiritual is "unreal". God is here to say that the physical Tabernacle here upon the earth is merely a model or copy of the REAL Tabernacle in Heaven! Spiritual things are actually the REAL things! They are more substantial that the physical through faith!

Fifty chapters in the Word of God are given over to the construction, pattern, and service of the Tabernacle Every aspect of the Tabernacle was dictated to Moses by God and was

carefully carried out by Moses

Why All This Fuss?

God is very interested that we should know about the Tabernacle. Creation is absolutely crucial to the Bible, yet God devoted only two full chapters to it. Why? God's main subject is the story of human redemption! Creation cost God nothing but His breath and words, but redemption cost Him His BEST (the Lord Jesus) and His blood!

Not a single aspect of the Tabernacle was left up to human creativity, imagination, or ability! Everything was clearly, carefully, meticulously detailed to Moses and from Moses to Spirit-filled men. Exodus 31:1-5 When it comes to salvation man can add NOTHING of any lasting value to what God has done!

- Tabernacle of the Testimony Num. 1:50- A Witness to the Preservation and Presentation of the Scriptures


